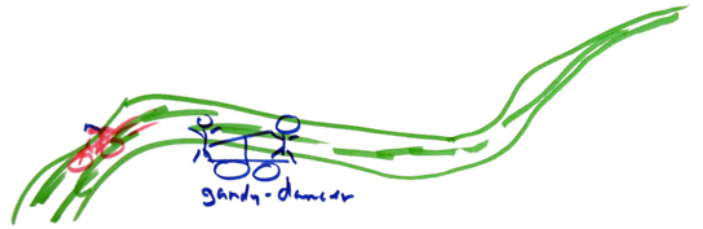


Rail Trail
