Resilient Central Coast empowers residents to take action for climate. Together, we aim to activate 500,000 households to cut emissions in half by 2030. In 2023, our inaugural year, over 1,500 residents committed to over 1,000 climate actions, saving nearly 200 tons of CO₂ through our campaign.

In 2023, Ecology Action united existing active transportation efforts under Modo, a scalable initiative designed to make active, low-carbon transportation accessible for everyone.

This year the Modo team:



Taught 8,972 elementary students lifelong bike and pedestrian safety skills.

Led 70 community bike events, engaging 3,916 people

Reached 36,520 people with opportunities to develop safer biking and walking plans for their communities.

With assistance from our EVs for Everyone/EVs Para Todos program, people are quickly joining the electric vehicle revolution. In 2023, we connected with 7,180 individuals, resulting in 421 people participating in our bilingual EV purchase guidance program, half of whom (56%) were from marginalized communities.

Ratio Institute partners with supermarkets nation-wide to improve operational efficiency and implement sustainable practices. This team is galvanizing food retailers to drastically reduce their GHG emissions and raise the bar through reporting and governance.

Ecology Action's B-Corp subsidiary is leading the way in providing comprehensive energy efficiency for commercial buildings and helping to build a decarbonized future.

This year, Taper initiated 1,300 projects with estimated annual savings of 43.8 million kwh of electricity* and 1 million therms of natural gas, equating to 36,807 Metric Tons of CO₂ emissions.

This is equivalent to 6,044 homes energy use for one year.*

In 2024, we are excited to grow our impact through energy-saving projects that will benefit 50 food banks in vulnerable communities in across the west with a recent award from the U.S. Department of Energy.
